Reunion Groups

Everyone will experience something different in their personal Journey to Damascus experience. The Parable of Sower (Matt 13) is particularly relevant to your own personal experience. Where did your spiritual seed fall? What have you done with the spiritual gift from God? Through this pandemic period of 2020-21, the JTD Board of Directors, Board of Trustees, the various committees, and the community have continued to prayerfully reach out and sow seeds on good soil.

Every day after your JTD experience is the 4th day, with an opportunity to plant the seed "where it produced a crop—a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown". This is a primary goal of the Reunion Groups. Just as in past years, the 4th Day Committee reaches out the reunion groups to update our rosters and contacts for each upcoming Journey weekend preparing a place for pilgrims to plant their seeds and continue to grow in spirit producing a great yield. The 4th Day Committee – Delfina (Dale) Hernandez, Theresa Arzimendi, Doug Walker, Allen Daehne and me – have reached out the local reunion groups for updates. We will have an update "active" reunion group list by mid-August.

Though gathering has been difficult and more so now with the sudden resurgence. There has been more concern for the health and well-being of our brothers and sisters in Christ. We cannot shut ourselves off. Dr. Charles Stanley of *In-Touch Ministry* stated, "The Christian life is not one of isolation and independence but of relationship and interconnection...God wants to use each of us at various times and in different ways to encourage others." "To encourage someone is simply to let them know they're not alone, to go to their side and walk with them on their journey." We must continue to gather in our small groups. Reunion Groups were created to support and sustain our spiritual and emotional growth.

The following was posted in a devotional (Source: https://dailyverse.knowing-jesus.com/hebrews-10-24) "As believers we are also instructed to be concerned about our brothers and sisters in Christ and to stir up one another unto love and good deeds. We are to care for each other and consider how to stimulate one another to love as Christ loved us, and to produce good deeds that God has prepared for us to do. We as believers are instructed: to provoke others unto love and to good works."

We need to find new avenues to reach the Body of Christ, to provide loving support as we face the challenges of our 4th day. We encourage you to start new reunion groups to reach others in the community. Contact those from your table, contact team members, reach out to others in your church community, encourage churches and businesses to provide a quiet and safe environment allowing the love of Christ to sprout like the seed planted in rich soil. There are opportunities through group meeting platforms, conference calls, and group text as well as face to face meetings. Christ is counting on you!

- If you are forming a new group or reestablishing a former group, pick a day and time each
 week and stick to it. Regular attendance is important and will eventually develop into a
 habit.
- What is said at Reunion Group, stays at Reunion Group. We are a prayer group seeking support in keeping the fire of God lit in our hearts, not a gossip circle.
- Use the Reunion Group cards given to you at the end of your Journey Weekend to keep your meetings focused on sharing about your experiences with your Holy life. We know it's easy to get off topic but keeping group meetings the same length of time consistently will keep members coming back.

If you need help with your Reunion Group, need more Order of Reunion Group cards or have any specific questions regarding this topic, please feel free to reach out to any Board Member. We are here to help you succeed and thrive with your Reunion Group! Remember, once we start having Journeys again, our pilgrims will need Reunion Groups to attend. The centerpiece of both the Walk and Journey experience is the Blessed Sacrament, Holy Communion, the Lord's Table. 
